

Sleepy Bear's Heart Blanket

Corner-to-Corner Graph

This handy graph will tell you where to make your color changes as you work your way through each row of the pattern. The blanket is worked from the bottom right corner to the top left corner, as indicated by the arrows. When you get to Row 9, attach your blue yarn in the last yarn over of the last dc of the 2nd white block. Work 5 blocks in blue, attaching the other ball of white in the last dc of the 5th block. Do not carry non-working yarns along the back. Instead let each hang out until you pick it up on the way back in the next row. You will find that you need to break your white yarn after you've completed the 2nd block of Row 15 and reattach it for the color change back to white at the top of the heart in Row 16.
